**SUBJECT** 

ADOPTION OF THE NEW DILG SHARED VISION

#### I. BACKGROUND

The current thrusts and priorities of the Administration and the public's strong clamor for a more responsive and effective government service pushed the Department to craft a new DILG Vision that will inspire all the personnel of the DILG and its Attached Agencies to work collectively as one DILG Family to bring about real change in the areas of local governance as well as in the peace and order and public safety fronts.

The crafting of the new DILG Vision was done through a series of consultations with DILG officials, personnel as well as our various stakeholders. It is also anchored on the Ambisyon 2040 crafted by the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) which reflects the dreams and aspirations of the Filipino People and the Socio Economic Agenda of President Rodrigo Roa Duterte.

This new Vision will serve as our guide and blueprint in implementing programs, projects and reforms that will help the President fulfil his promises to the people and make the Department a dynamic, responsive and highly-trusted agency of the national government today and in the future.

#### II. THE NEW DILG SHARED VISION

"A strongly determined and highly trusted Department committed to capacitate and nurture local government units, public order and safety institutions to sustain peaceful, progressive, and resilient communities where people live happily."

#### III. KEY ELEMENTS OF THE NEW VISION

#### IV. DISSEMINATION AND ADOPTION

- A. All Heads of Agencies/Offices/Units under the DILG Family shall:
  - 1. Ensure that all Programs, Projects and Initiatives of your respective offices are aligned, consistent, and are responsive to the new DILG shared Vision;
  - 2. Disseminate/cascade the Vision to all personnel of his/her Agency/Office/Unit, down to the field offices in cities and municipalities;
  - 3. Ensure that the Vision Statement is posted prominently on the respective Agency/Office/Unit Website, Social Media Accounts, and conspicuous places in your office;
  - 4. Require all personnel to recite the Vision during Flag Raising Ceremony and flash/show the same (in PowerPoint format) during big events sponsored/organized by the Agency/Office/Unit; and
  - 5. Require that PowerPoint presentations emanating from your respective Agency/Office/Unit include the said Vision in the second slide (next to the title slide), if deemed appropriate.
- B. All Personnel of DILG and its Attached Agencies shall:
  - 1. Memorize the new DILG shared Vision:
  - 2. Embody the ideals and aspirations reflected in the new DILG Vision; and
  - 3. Fully support, cooperate and collaborate in the implementation of all the Programs, Projects, and Activities leading to the achievement and realization of the new DILG Vision.

#### V. REFERENCE MATERIAL

To ensure the consistency of messaging in the dissemination/cascading of the new DILG Vision to all personnel of the DILG Family, attached is a one-paged briefer for reference.
