SECOND NATIONAL INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT

EXHIBITION AND ENVIRONMENT SUMMIT

The Second National Integrated Waste Management Exhibition and Environment Summit will be held on June 21-24, 2016 at MegaTrade Halls 1 and 2, SM Megamall, EDSA, Ortigas Center, Mandaluyong City. Said activity will be organized by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources-Environmental Management Bureau, National Solid Waste Management Commission, Office of Senator Loren Legarda, Metro Manila Development Authority and Climate Change Commission, and hosted by the City of Mandaluyong.

The Exhibition will showcase initiatives, best practices and emerging technologies that address the challenges posed by environmental pollution and degradation to the economy, and people's livelihood, health and survival. Some 100 exhibitors will be displaying their programs and projects on, among others, reducing greenhouse gas emissions, recycling, emerging technologies on integrated waste management, water conservation, energy, and pollution control.

In view of the foregoing, city and municipal mayors are hereby encouraged to attend this training on official business. Corresponding travel expenses, and other incidental expenses may be authorized chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, provided, that the said registration fees and travel expenses of participants shall not be charged against the 20% Development Fund or from whatever source which may prejudice poverty reduction efforts.
