SUBJECT : PARTICIPATION TO THE 1ST NABPLO CONVENTION 2017

In response to President Rodrigo Roa Duterte's desire of promoting the ease of doing business in the country so as to encourage more investors and to support the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), the National Association of Business Permits and Licensing Officers (NABPLO), in partnership with the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), will be conducting the First (1st) NABPLO Convention with the theme, "2017 NABPLO National Convention: Converge – Uniting for Global Competitiveness" on November 27-28, 2017 at the Solaire Resort and Casino, and Blue Leaf Filipinas, Parañaque City.


The convention aims to provide an interactive venue that will discuss pressing issues of common and critical concerns among local government units (LGUs) with the business sectors and to explore collaborative partnership with national agencies in developing key policy frameworks and instruments for global competitiveness.

In this connection, all City and Municipal Mayors together with their Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) Heads are encourage to participate in the above-mentioned activity on official business. The payment of corresponding travelling and accommodation expenses, and registration fee of Ten Thousand Pesos (PhP 10,000.00) which covers costs of conference materials and meals for the two-day event, may be authorized, chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, provided, that said registration fees and travelling expenses of participants shall not be charged against the twenty percent (20%) Development Fund or from whatever source which may prejudice poverty alleviation efforts.
