2017 18-DAY CAMPAIGN TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST

WOMEN (VAW)

Proclamation 1172, Series of 2006 declares November 25 to December 12 of every year as the "18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW)" and Republic Act 10398. Series of 2012 declares November 25 of every year as "National Consciousness Day For The Elimination of Violence Against Women and Children."

In pursuance of the above, the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) in coordination with the Inter-Agency Council on Violence Against Women and Their Children (IACVAWC) is spearheading the nationwide observance of this year's 18-Day Campaign to End VAW from November 25 to December 12, 2017 with the theme "VAW-free community starts with Me."

To ensure its success, all local government units (LGUs) are hereby encouraged to observe the 18-Day Campaign to End VAW in their respective localities and initiate activities for synchronized efforts in line with the theme.

The following are the suggested activities for guidance of the LGUs:

- Hanging of the official streamer bearing this year's campaign theme. Streamer from the **PCW** website downloaded be design can http://pcw.gov.ph/VAWfreePH2017;
- Uploading of the official logo and advocacy materials for the 18-Day Campaign to End VAW in the agency/LGU/organization's official website and social media sites;
- Development of information, education and communication (IEC) materials to raise awareness on VAW like fans and flyers for their clienteles. PCW-developed materials may be reproduced by agencies, provided that the content and design of the material is retained. Printer-ready copy of the materials can be downloaded via https://tinyurl.com/Anti-VAW-IEC. The uploaded materials are designed for interested organizations to incorporate their official logo below the phrase "Reprinted and distributed by:" so that due acknowledgment could be given to their contribution to the campaign;

- Organizing activities related to this year's theme and focus during 18-Day Campaign period, with both external and internal stakeholders as participants;
- Participation in online campaign threads and discussions about the observance using hashtag #VAWfreePH;
- Participation in the nationwide Orange Your Icon Advocacy Initiative;
- Conduct of other anti-VAW activities in line with the needs of their stakeholders;
 and
- For regional/field offices and LGUs: Coordination with other government regional offices or LGUs for inter-agency/LGU collaboration in holding a kick-off activity on November 24 (refer to Annex 1 for suggested program: VAW: The Unspoken Words). Requirements and materials relative to the program can be downloaded from http://pcw.gov.ph/VAWfreePH2017.

Expenses related to the 2017 18-Day Campaign to End VAW may be charged to the Gender and Development (GAD) Budget and may be reflected in the 2017 GAD accomplishment reports of the government agencies, provided that the activities conducted are in line with the theme and focus are of concern stipulated in PCW Memorandum Circular No. 2017-04.
