2018 NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation Nos. 224 and 227 s. 1988 and Republic Act No. 6949, the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) leads the annual National Women's Month Celebration (NWMC) every March of the year.

Last year, the PCW Board Members and Inter-Agency Technical Working Group identified the NWMC theme "WE Make Change Work for Women", which shall be used from 2017 to 2022. The theme highlights the empowerment of women as active contributors to and claimholders of change and development.

To promote public awareness in the celebration of the event, all LGUs are encouraged to undertake related activities, such as:

PRODUCTION OF INFORMATION, EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION (IEC) **MATERIALS**

- Hanging of 2018 NWMC official streamer in all government agencies, including regional offices and local government units (LGUs);
- Development, production and distribution of IEC materials for 2018 NWMC which include collaterals designed by PCW and agency-specific materials like flyers that feature LGU services offered to their women clients; and
- Wearing Purple T-shirts/blouses/polo every Thursday of March (March 1, 8, 15 and 22, 2018) in support of #PurpleThursdays.

PARTICIPATION TO WOMEN'S MONTH ONLINE ADVOCACY

- Uploading of the official logo, advocacy video and other National Women's Month advocacy materials in government agencies' website, Facebook, Youtube and Twitter pages and using of 2018 NWMC Facebook Camera Effects;
- · Participating in the online campaign thread about the observance using the hashtag #WomenMakeChange;

- Featuring the organization's calendar of activities and activity implementation reports and Women's Month advocacy materials in their official websites, social media accounts and publications, and sending links to the reports to PCW through email address: events.pcw@gmail.com; and
