Memorandum Circular No. 2018-72

1.0 Background

1.1. Peace and security are vital to national development. There can be no meaningful development in any society without security. However, both security and development are unitary concepts of governance. While the connection of security to development is tied to social, political, economic and cultural institutions that influence the growth of society, governance impacts the two.

1.2. The Department of National Defense (DND), in collaboration with this Department shall embark on an intervention that relates to a framework of interlinked processes of governance through an executive course on security, peace and development. The course shall focus on understanding security and its interdependence with good governance and improvements in the socio-economic conditions of communities. The course shall be delivered through lectures and sharing from experts and practitioners, and practical workshops, so that the dynamics that occur in the interaction of governance, security and development can be better understood and applied.

2.0 Purpose

- 2.1. The purpose of the policy is to enjoin concerned city and municipal mayors in Mindanao to attend the Executive Course on Security, Peace and Development, particularly as the course is aimed at achieving the following objectives:
 - 2.1.1. Explain the principles behind security interventions,
 - 2.1.2. Suggest practical approaches to implementing them to ensue social and economic development through good governance, and
 - 2.1.3. Provide a venue for stakeholders to discuss convergence of initiatives.

3.0 Scope/Coverage

3.1. All City and Municipal Mayors and DILG Regional Directors in Mindanao, ARMM Regional Governor, and all others concerned, to help them work through the steps involved in planning, implementing, evaluating and improving security interventions

4.0 Policy Content and Guidelines

- 4.1. There are two (2) batches out of 12, identified as of 15 May 2018, with the rest to be determined by the DND accordingly.
- 4.2. The first two batches shall be held on the following schedules at the Marco Polo Hotel, Davao City:

4.2.1. May 24-26, 2018 - First batch

4.2.2. June 07-09, 2018 - Second batch

4.3. A list of the LGU participants per batch is hereinto attached for easy reference. The list of LGUs for the succeeding batches shall be provided by the DND as soon as it is available.

4.4. Traveling and accommodation expenses of attendees shall be charged against respective LGU fund subject to availability and to existing accounting, budgeting, and auditing rules and regulations.

4.5. The local chief executive shall personally undergo the executive course and **no proxy** shall be assigned to represent him/her thereto.

4.6. The DILG Regional Directors concerned and the ARMM Regional Governor are directed to disseminate this Memorandum Circular in their respective areas of coverage, and shall likewise confirm the attendance of the concerned local chief executives.
