YOUTH SUSTAINABILITY CONVERGENCE

Republic Act No. 8044 otherwise known as the Youth in Nation-Building Act supports the principle of mobilization of youth's abilities, talents and skills and redirecting their creativity, inventive genius and wellspring of enthusiasm and hope for the freedom of our people from fear, hunger and injustice.

The UN Sustainable Development Solutions Network (UN SDSN Youth-Philippines), in partnership with the National Youth Commission – Office of the President, the Forum for Family Planning and Development, Inc., the Ten Accomplished Youth Organizations Foundation, Inc., aim to educate young people about the Sustainable Development Goals and provide opportunities for them to pioneer innovative solutions to address the world's biggest challenges.

To promote the importance of sustainable development and sustainability, UN SDSN -Youth Philippines will be having the "Youth Sustainability Convergence" with the theme "The Emergence of Solutions Leaders for 2030 Philippines" from August 15-19, 2019 at the Baguio Teacher's Camp, Baguio City.

In view of the above, all local chief executives are hereby encouraged to allow on official business the participation of their Sanggunian Kabataan Officials including Local Youth Development Officers to the abovementioned activity.

Payment of the conference fee of ₱5,500.00 for delegates without accommodation; ₱7,500.00 for pre-registered delegates; and ₱8,500.00 for delegates who register on-site may be allowed chargeable against their respective funds, subject to its availability, and the provisions of DBM-DILG-NYC Joint Memorandum Circular No.1 Series of 2019, dated 23 January 2019, entitled: "Guidelines on the Appropriation, Release, Planning, and Budgeting Process for SK Funds" in the case of SK officials, and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

To promote the importance of sustainable development and sustainability, UN SDSN – Youth Philippines will be having the "Youth Sustainability Convergence" with the theme "The Emergence of Solutions Leaders for 2030 Philippines" from August 15-19, 2019 at the Baguio Teacher's Camp, Baguio City.

Using interactive learning sessions and solutions-oriented workshops, the Youth Sustainability Convergence aims to:

- (a) Introduce the Sustainable Development Goals to the youth, particularly in light of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and educate young people about the importance and significance of SDGs and sustainability to the development of their communities and the Philippines.
- (b) Provide youth leaders a platform to learn, talk about, and integrate sustainability in their lives and in their work as local executives and legislators
- (c) Equip the youth, especially young legislators and executives, with skills and knowledge that would create a drive towards sustainability and the sustainable development in their communities through their work
- (d) Provide an avenue for the creation of local and national networks that would encourage the youth to be Solutions Leaders in different fields.
- (e) Provide platforms for youth to create concrete local youth-led programs to solve different problems in communities through their legislative and executive work.





























The Youth Sustainability Convergence event is a **four-day live** in convention in Baguio City for youth to have enough time and opportunity to interact and learn with one another. The **conference fee is at P5,5000 for delegations without accommodations, P7,500.00 for pre-registered delegates and P8,500.00 for delegates who register on-site**. The fee includes conference participation, accommodations, food and conference kits which shall include a booklet, a camp shirt, tumblers, pens, souvenirs among all.

We would like to ask the help of the **Department of Interior and Local Government** through issuing an **official memorandum circular** inviting all Sanguniang Kabataaan officials and members, Young legislators and executives, Local Youth Development Councils Offices, and Youth Offices in all barangays, cities, and regions in the Philippines to attend the said event. We propose, and as what was discussed with the National Youth Commission, **that the funding for the registration fees and other expenses related to this conference can be taken from budget of the the Local Government Units.** Though, as per consultation with COA on their Memorandum Circular dated on June 17,2019 on the JMC entitled "Guidelines on the Appropriation, Release, Planning, and Budgeting Process for SK funds" the Sanguniang Kabataan can use their funds to attend capacity building activities and trainings like the Youth Sustainability Convergence – Though on this matter, we will be respecting the department's wisdom.

We have also attached the Youth Sustainability Convergence concept note and other pertinent documents to help you in making the advisory.



Through the Youth Solutions Convergence, young people shall be part of the history of formulating ideas, debating about development plans, and creating concrete projects for a world where no one is left behind.










DETAILS WORTH REMEMBERING




ACTIVITIES AND THE ASOS FRAMEWORK

Through the ASOS framework of SDSN Youth, Participants would be grounded on different principles regarding Society, Self, Organizations and organizational affairs, and Solutions making. The ASOS framework at work is SDSN Youth Philippines' primary response for young people's development.



PLENARY SESSIONS



The Plenary sessions aim to equip participants with knowledge on the SDGs, the youth situation in the Philippines, and the collective solutions and actions young people are doing for sustainable development throughout the country.

Participated in by everyone, the session aims to as well be a networking tool for young leaders to connect with each other and to discuss different issues and solutions for their communities.









Breakout Sessions for Advocacy Enrichment

The Breakout Sessions for Advocacy Enrichment comes from the idea that effective organizations are grounded on good operational skills and are founded on best practices.

With industry captains from the academe and the private sector, **young leaders would learn practical skills in running their organizations**. Topics include fundraising, human resource management, community organizing, and project implementation.

Through different immersions in different advocacy work spaces of companies and NGOs, participants will have first hand experience and close-up learning sessions on the development sector and how it seeks to change the landscape of the Philippines









PLANET FAIR COMPETITION

"There is no plan B because we do not have a Planet B." UN Sec. Gen. Ban Ki Moon has urged people to work and galvanize actions to help create a world where no one is left behind. It is through this call that the Youth Sustainability Convergence shall be a spring board for youth ideas and innovations for Sustainable Development.

Through the Planet Fair Competition, delegations or groups of eight to ten youth leaders from the same organizations have a chance to start concrete and real solutions for Sustainable Development. SDSN Youth will be giving **seed funding for innovations** that can solve real community problems. Mechanics for this competition will be announced a month before the event.

SUSTAINABILITY EXPO


In this four-day expo, different non-government organizations, social enterprises, and private companies shall showcase different sustainability and sustainable development programs being implemented by their institutions.




